Sasa Zivic was born in 1971 in Nis.

He attended primary and secondary grammar school in Nis. He graduated from the Medical Faculty of the University of Nis in 1998. He specialized in general surgery in 2004. He attained his Master's Degree in Medical Sciences in the field of vascular surgery in 2006. He is completing his PhD studies in the field of cardiac surgery and cardiac surgery subspecialist studies at the Medical Faculty of the University of Belgrade.

He has been working at Nis Clinical Center since 1999 where he was the head of the Department for Venous Diseases and Chief of Department Specialist, Consultative and Diagnostic Suggestions. Since 2012, he has been at the position of the Assistant Director of the Vascular Surgery Clinic at Nis Clinical Center.
